1. Choose A Pattern







2. Gather Supplies

- Measuring Tape
- Marking pen (Water Soluble or Chalk)
- ☐ Fashion Multi Tool by Sew To Grow Long Frech Curve (optional)
- Seam Gauge
- Regular Scissors and Fabric Scissors
- Glass Head and Flower Head Pins
- ☐ Sewing Pattern of Choice

- 2 Meters of muslin/calico fabric to test fit. (plain color medium weight cotton fabric)
- 2 Meters of tracing paper/interfacing for tracing design (AKA: Pattern Ease, Vielene Tracing Interfacing)
- ☐ Coordinating Thread (Rasant/Guetermann)
- ☐ Pins (Flat Head and Glass Head)
- ☐ Sewing Machine in good working order. Optional: Bring Overlocker/Serger on Day 2

3. Choose a Fabric

- Voile, Rayon, Medium Weight Cotton, and other light weight materials Please do not bring slinky or innappropriate fabric from home. This is a fast pace class, so to ensure proper fit and success of your first garment, please purchase from your retailer that is supporting this class

4. Purchase Fabric for Final Garment Based on 44' (110cm) Fabric.
