1. Bondi Top Pattern



2. Gather Supplies

☐ Self Measuring Tape (or normal measuring tape)	1.5 Meters of muslin/calico fabric to test fit.
☐ Marking utensil (Water Soluble or Chalk)	(plain color medium weight cotton fabric)
Fashion Multi Tool by Sew To Grow Long Frech Curve (highly recommended)	2 Meters of tracing paper/interfacing for tracing design (AKA: Pattern Ease, Vielene Tracing Interfacing)
Seam Gauge (optional if you have Multi Tool	Coordinating Thread (Rasant/Guetermann)
Regular Scissors and Fabric Scissors	Sewing Machine in good working order. Optional: Bring Overlocker/Serger on Day 2
☐ Flower Head Pins and normal pins	1/2m (yd) extra fabric to make bias in class
3. Choose a Fabric	or purchase 1yd/m of 25mm wide bias. Double fold is fine.

Choose a fabric that is appropriate for the garment you are making for best results. Also keep in mind your skill level. The class is built around fitting, so you don't want to waist time with aligning prints, stressing about directional prints, or fussing with challenging fabrics. I recommend a stable medium weight cotton for best results for your first class.

4. Purchase Fabric for Final Garment

Based on 44' (110cm) Fabric.
Allow extra for more length if desired ______
